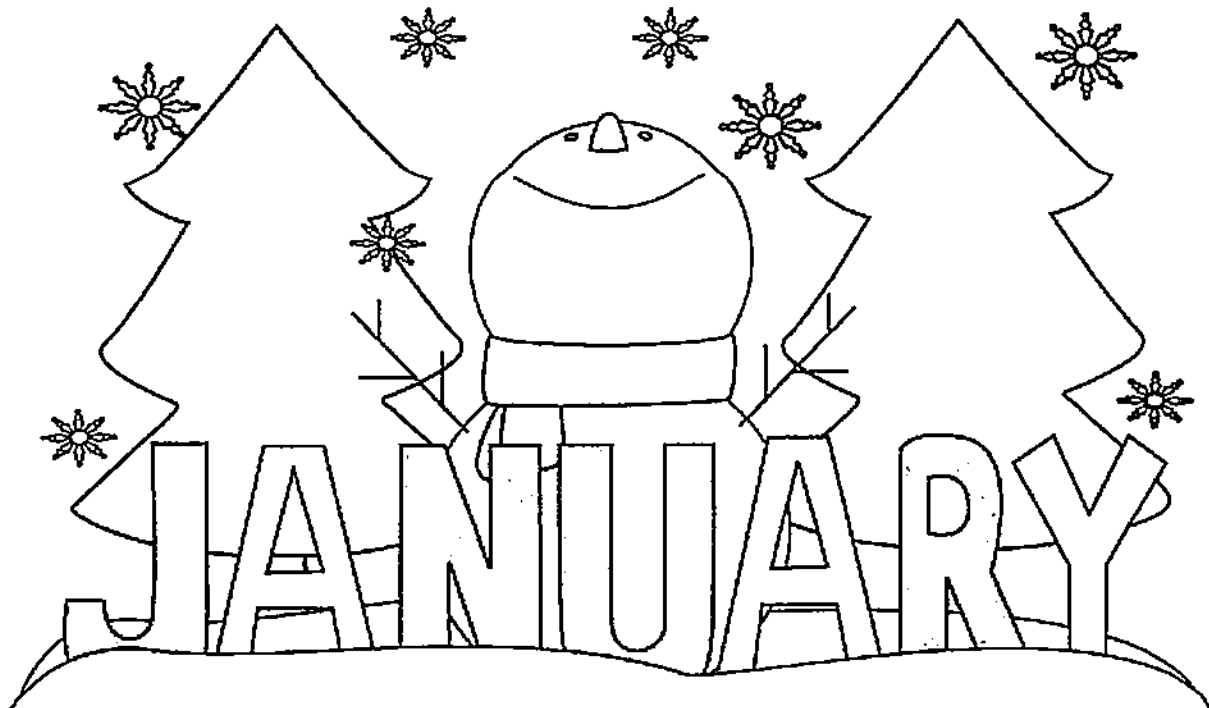


December 29th - Movie elf at 3:00 PM in the clubhouse. We will be serving cookies and hot chocolate.

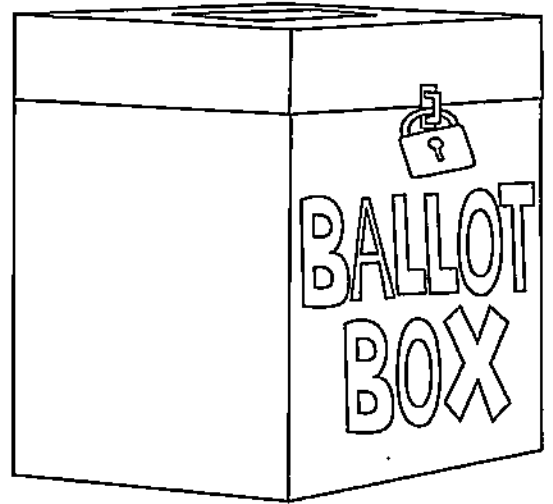

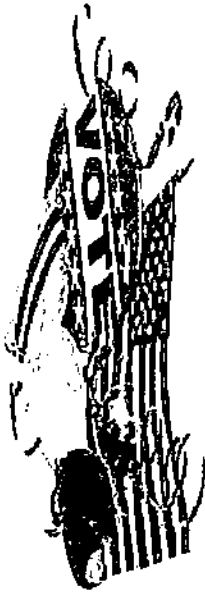
