

Yard Waste

As of December 1, 2020, we will be stopping the Yard Waste Pick-up Program for the season. We will restart the program next spring.

We recently called and confirmed that Aces Waste Services does not offer green waste pick up in County areas at this time, which we are part of, they only offer that within the city limits. They are considering possibly adding green waste services for county residents next year, so we will keep you posted as we hear more, but in the meantime, you can haul your green waste to Aces.

Towards the end of 2020, Aces Waste Services will be sending out information to all of its customers about their new waste voucher cards. Customers will receive a scannable card that they can use to take up to 1 cubic yard (approximately 3' x 3' x 3') of waste to the Aces lone facility at no charge annually (card will reload each year at the beginning of the year). Additionally, at some future point, they will announce an additional "Community" waste event where Aces customers will be able to take another yard of waste at no charge.
