Yard Waste Pick-up

Yard waste pick-up will resume on May 3. All Yard waste must be in 32-gallon plastic containers or large garbage bags. Yard waste must not be more than 3 feet in length. ONLY yard waste will be pick-up. Acceptable yard waste includes: Leaves, grass trimmings, tree and shrub prunings, Christmas trees, and sod with dirt removed. Unacceptable Yard Waste includes: trash and debris, pet feces, excessive amount of dirt, lumber, and concrete. If your yard waste is not in a container or bag, it will NOT be picked-up.
