Yard Trimmings Pick-up

There are new rules for yard trimmings pick-up.

All yard trimmings must be in a 32-gallon plastic container or large garbage bags. All containers or bags must be clearly labeled with resident's address. Only leaves, grass, tree and shrub trimmings, and Christmas trees will be accepted. Residences not complying with the rules will be given two written warnings, if a third warning is issued, resident may lose the privilege of having their yard waste picked-up and may also be fined.
